Template for Detailed Test Scripts

A detailed test script is essential to thoroughly explore and verify specific areas of a system, especially where risks are judged to be high. Here is a template and example of what a detailed test script might look like. This includes the necessary steps, expected results, and how to handle any deviations.

TEST SCRIPT ID

Add a unique identifier for the test script.

TEST CASE TITLE

Set a descriptive title that summarizes what the test script will verify.

PURPOSE

A brief description of the purpose of the test.

TESTER

Name of the person responsible for the test.

PRIORITY

Priority level (High, Medium, Low) based on risk assessment.

PREREQUISITES

Specific conditions that must be met before the test can be performed.

TEST DATA

Data required to perform the test.

TEST STEPS

Step #: What to do.



EXPECTED RESULT

What is expected to happen if the system works as it should.

POSTCONDITIONS

What state the system is expected to be in after the test is executed.

ACTUAL RESULTS

What actually happened when the test was performed.

STATUS

Status of the test (Passed, Not Passed, Error, etc.).

COMMENTS

Additional notes, observations, or issues identified during testing.

TEST CASE TITLE

Credit Card Payment Process Verification

PURPOSE

To ensure that the payment process works correctly with valid credit card details.

TEST MANAGER

Anna Svensson

PRIORITY

High

PREREQUISITES

The user must be logged in and have products in the shopping cart.



TEST DATA

Credit card type - Visa
Credit card number - 4111 1111 1111 1111
Expiry date - 12/23
CVV - 123

TEST STEPS

Step 1 - Go to the shopping cart.

• Expected result: The shopping cart is displayed with listed products.

Step 2 - Click "Proceed to Checkout".

• Expected result: The payment form is displayed.

Step 3 - Fill in the payment information above.

• Expected result: Information is accepted without error messages.

Step 4 - Click on "Make Payment".

 Expected result: Payment is made and a confirmation of the purchase is displayed.

POST TERMS

The user's account should be debited and an order confirmation should be sent by email.

ACTUAL RESULTS

To be completed during test execution

STATUS

To be updated after the test has been completed.

COMMENTS

Any problems or deviations are noted here.

This test script is designed to thoroughly test a critical function of an e-commerce system, ensuring that all steps are correctly performed and documented, which is essential for managing high-risk areas of software projects.
